### PRAYER BEFORE MASS

Loving Father, as on my earthly pilgrimage I now receive Your beloved Son under the veil of a sacrament, may I one day see Him face to face in glory, who lives and reigns with You for ever.*

### PRAYER AFTER MASS

*I thank you, holy Lord, almighty Father, eternal God, who have deigned to feast me, sinful and unworthy servant, with the precious body and blood of your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. I pray not for any merit of mine, but only because of Your merciful goodness. And I pray that this Holy Communion, far from condemning me to punishment, may bring about my pardon and salvation, encompassing me with the armor of faith and the shield of a good will. By it let my vices be done away, all lustful desires extinguished. May it advance me in charity, patience, humility, obedience, and every other virtue. Let it be strong defense against the wiles of all my enemies, visible and invisible, allaying for me every disturbance of flesh and spirit, binding me firmly to you, the one true God, and bringing my last hour to a happy close. I pray, too, that it may be your pleasure to call my sinful self one day to that banquet, wonderful past all telling, where You, with Your Son and the Holy Spirit, feast Your saints with the vision of Yourself, who are true light, the fulfillment of all desires, the joy that knows no ending, gladness unalloyed and perfect bliss: through the same Christ our Lord.*

**SAINTS OF THE WEEK – JANUARY 16TH**

**The Five Protomartyrs of the Franciscan Order** were the first missionaries St. Francis of Assisi sent to the land of the Saracens in Spain and Morocco, North Africa. The Franciscan Order was officially approved in 1215, and four years later, in 1219, the five, Bros. Berard, Otho, Peter, Accursius and Adjutus left Assisi and traveled by foot to Coimbra, Portugal where they stayed with the Augustinian friars. While there, they met Fr. Fernando de Bulhoes (later named St. Anthony of Padua), who was inspired to join the Franciscan Order by their martyrdom, to also become a missionary, and if God willing, a martyr also. God had other plans. Anthony's ship to Morocco was blown off course to Italy where he would become one of the most beloved Franciscans. The five friars began preaching to Muslim believers in the mosques in Seville, Spain. They were shortly taken prisoners, beaten and then taken to Morocco before Sultan Muhammad al-Nasir. He ordered them to never preach in the name of Christ again. When released they again fearlessly resumed preaching of Christ and were arrested again. In detention, they would be repeatedly flogged, and each time questioned if they intended to continue, they answered they could not stop proclaiming the name of Jesus. They were beheaded in Morocco on January 16, 1220, thus sealing their sainthood as martyrs for Christ.
